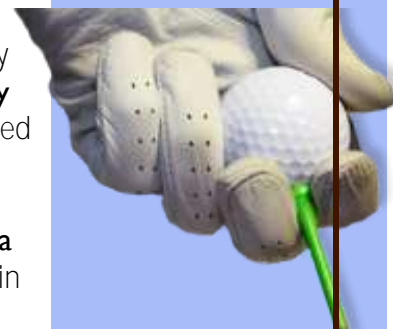
### Get Your Equipment Ready For Spring

- **Please try to keep carts on the path whenever possible**
